"He invokes fear in the rest of the world," she asserts, suggesting that Trump's unpredictability helps reinforce America's global stance.

Brooke Riske, an educator from Virginia, transformed from a skeptic into a supporter, citing Trump's steady presence during the uncertainty of the pandemic. "He kept our country very peaceful for several years," she claims. Finally, Jeremy Stevens, a small business owner, reflects on Trump's industrial policies that resonate with his belief that "the country is a giant business to be run." With crucial issues like inflation at the forefront, these supporters feel Trump's return could mean a return to what they consider American prosperity. The fervor and conviction of Trump's supporters remain evident as the 2024 campaign unfolds, igniting heated discussions nationwide.
