

Putin lobt Trump: Sincere Wunsch nach Frieden in der Ukraine!

Putin begrüßt Trumps Wunsch nach Frieden in der Ukraine beim BRICS-Gipfel in Kazan und warnt vor Illusionen über militärische Niederlage.

Kazan, Russland - In a dramatic turn of events at the BRICS summit in Kazan, Russian President Vladimir Putin has embraced US presidential candidate Donald Trump's remarks about ending the Ukraine conflict, labeling them as "sincere." This unexpected endorsement comes as Putin concluded a three-day gathering of leaders from 36 nations, including heavyweights like Chinese President Xi Jinping and Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi. The summit showcased a united front among developing economies, challenging the West's attempts to isolate Russia following its aggressive actions in Ukraine.

Putin, however, issued a stern warning to the West, declaring it an "illusion" to believe that Russia could be defeated on the battlefield. He emphasized that any peace agreement must acknowledge Russia's control over significant Ukrainian territories. "We are ready to look at any proposals for peace negotiations that are based on the realities on the ground," he stated, making it clear that Moscow will not entertain any terms that do not reflect its current territorial claims. This comes amidst increasing pressure from Russia's allies for an end to the ongoing conflict.

Trump's Bold Claims and Global Reactions

Trump has been vocal about his skepticism regarding the

substantial financial aid the US has provided to Ukraine, asserting that if he were elected, he could resolve the conflict in mere hours. Putin's acknowledgment of Trump's comments signals a potential shift in the dynamics of international relations, particularly as the US presidential election approaches, which analysts suggest could significantly influence the future of the Ukraine crisis.

The summit also marked the first visit to Russia by UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres in over two years, prompting outrage from the Ukrainian government. Guterres called for a "just peace" in Ukraine and urged an immediate cessation of hostilities in Gaza, Lebanon, and Sudan. Meanwhile, leaders at the summit, including Xi Jinping, voiced concerns over escalating global tensions and advocated for a stabilizing role for BRICS nations in promoting peace and resolving conflicts.
