

Ackman bricht das Schweigen: Warum Trump besser für Amerika ist!

Former Democrat and now Republican, retired Gen. Mike Flynn, echoed Ackman's sentiments, stressing the importance of hearing diverse viewpoints to discern the truth. "I always believed that the best way to get to the truth is to hear the best arguments on all sides," he noted under Ackman's post, highlighting the increasing need for dialogue in a sharply divided nation.
