

Rescue of Wildcats: Scottish Predators return to freedom!

Am 10. Januar 2025 reports today AT about the project "Saving Wildcats", which rescues wildcats in Scotland and documents them.

Cairngorms National Park, Scotland - In Scotland, engaged nature conservationists are working for the preservation of the endangered wildcat. The project "Saving Wildcats" has already achieved success, as it has released wildcats, which were bred in captivity, into the Cairngorms National Park. These remarkable animals, which are closely related to our domestic cats, are increasingly adapting to their environment, which is a great hope for their population. Responsible for the project is the Royal Zoological Society of Scotland, which is working together with various partners, including Scottish Natural Heritage and the Cairngorms National Park Authority, to protect these impressive predators and enable their return to the wild, as [heute.at](#) reported.

In support of this initiative, a two-part documentary with the title "Wildcats: Cait ann an Cunnart" from BBC ALBA will be broadcast, which documents the first steps of the wildcats in their new environment. This documentary not only highlights the successes of the program, but also the challenges, which the wildcats face as they learn to survive independently in the rugged landscape. According to Dr. Helen Senn, project leader, the film highlights the experiences and difficulties of rehabilitating a

Diese inspirierende Geschichte gibt Einblick in die Herzstück der Naturschutzarbeit in Schottland und zeigt, wie wichtig der Einsatz für den Erhalt gefährdeter Arten ist.
