

## Justiz schlägt zu: Tommy Robinson wegen Missachtung des Gerichts verurteilt!

Tommy Robinson, der umstrittene britische Aktivist, wurde zu 18 Monaten Gefängnis verurteilt wegen Missachtung des Gerichts im Fall eines syrischen Flüchtlings.

**London, UK** - **London:** In a dramatic twist, notorious far-right provocateur Tommy Robinson has been sentenced to 18 months behind bars. The infamous activist, whose real name is Stephen Yaxley-Lennon, was found guilty of contempt of court over a long-running libel case involving a Syrian refugee. This latest development underscores his continued clash with the law, marking yet another prison term for one of the UK's leading anti-Muslim figures, who has faced growing backlash for inciting antiimmigration riots earlier this year.

Robinson's fate was sealed at Woolwich Crown Court in southeast London after he admitted to a staggering 10 counts of breaching a 2021 High Court ruling. This order explicitly prohibited him from making false claims about the refugee, claims that had resulted in a successful libel suit against him. Judge Jeremy Johnson, delivering a scathing condemnation of Robinson's actions, declared them a "planned, deliberate, direct, flagrant breach of the court's orders." He affirmed, "Nobody is above the law," emphasizing the importance of community order and compliance with legal injunctions.

## **Supporters and Controversy**

Attired in a grey suit and visibly subdued, Robinson faced his

downfall while supporters gathered in court, echoing a turbulent atmosphere. Having turned himself in after evading a prior court appearance, he stood accused of "thumbing his nose at the court." Legal representatives further alleged his actions undermined the rule of law, criticizing a film he helped produce that perpetuated the same damaging allegations. Despite the backlash, Robinson maintains a fervent online following, bolstered by anti-immigrant and anti-Muslim rhetoric.

The echoes of Robinson's name were loud during recent antiimmigrant riots across England and Northern Ireland, which ignited following false claims about violent incidents linked to a Muslim asylum seeker. His longstanding involvement with farright movements has kept him in the spotlight, particularly after gaining renewed traction on social media following a high-profile account restoration. As thousands marched through London demanding his release over the weekend, Robinson's controversial stance continues to polarize public opinion and ignite fierce debates on freedom of speech versus hate speech.
